

BRING YOUR MEDICATION LIST

A substantial amount of work is going on in the area of medication safety at Wexford General Hospital. However, there are many challenges around medication reconciliation and we would like to encourage patients themselves to play their role in reducing medication errors.

As part of this we are encouraging all members of the public to carry a complete list of their medications at all times – preferably using the My Medicines List template


The HSE has launched a campaign called **Know, Check, Ask** and a tool for the public to help improve the safe use of medicines. It will help people who take medicines and everyone involved in their care to make better decisions about their treatment.

The campaign aims to empower patients and encourages people who take regular medicines, and those assisting them to:

- **Know** your medicines, keep a list, bringing it to appointments & if admitted to hospital
- **Check** that you are using the right medicine the right way
- **Ask** your healthcare professional if you're unsure

The HSE tool is a '[My Medicines List](http://www.safermeds.ie)' template which is available to download at www.safermeds.ie. People can of course, create their own list instead from their records. Your pharmacy can help you with this. Some people may find it useful to take a photo of their list and keep it on their phone.

Patients should bring their list to all hospital appointments and visits.

REFLECTION
NEVER WEARY OF DOING GOOD
 The name Corrie ten Boom was widely recognised in Christian circles but few knew about her nephew Peter who was instrumental in saving Jews from Nazi persecution. When Dutch patriots heard SS troops were sending Jewish orphans to concentration camps they smuggled kids out of orphanages and brought them to the ten Boom house until they could be placed for adoption. At 16 Peter defied the Germans by playing the Dutch national anthem in church while the whole congregation stood and sang. He was imprisoned for his defiance. After W.W.2 he travelled the world with the message that forgiveness is the only answer to hatred. On tour in Israel he had a heart attack and needed surgery. Talking to his cardiologist the night before his operation he was asked, 'Are you by any chance related to the ten Booms of Holland?' Peter replies, 'Yes that's my family'. Then the doctor responded. 'I'm one of the babies your family saved!' Next day the man whose life had been saved 40 yrs earlier, repaid the debt by saving Peter ten Boom's life. What you sow, good or bad, comes back to you. So, 'let us not become weary in doing good...at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up' (Ecclesiastes 11:1) - **Brought to you by the Diocesan Pastoral Council**
