REFLECTION
 We explore The 7 Sacraments. The Anointing of the Sick: is the meeting point where God comes to the aid of those who are sick and have lost their strength. The priest anoints the sick person with blessed oil on the forehead and hands. While doing so he says: “Through the holy anointing may the Lord in His mercy help you with the grace of the Holy Spirit. May the Lord who frees you from sin save you and raise you up.” It is not right to say that the Anointing of the Sick is only for the dying. In serious spiritual need or before an operation, people also ask for the Anointing of the Sick. How often can you receive the Anointing of the Sick? As often as a person needs it. You can receive the Anointing of the Sick if you are seriously ill, especially when the condition is worsening. It does not matter whether you are old or young. The Anointing of the Sick also helps us to endure the hardship of dying. Jesus is the only one who is able to accompany you when you are dying and lead you through death to heavenly life. To end, a quote from Scripture: “Jesus made a tour through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the Good News of the kingdom and curing all kinds of disease and sickness. And when he saw crowds he felt sorry for them because they were harassed and dejected, like sheep without a shepherd (Mt 9:35-36). - *Brought to you by The Diocesan Pastoral Council*
