REFLECTION

The bible is the most important book in the world. Written in it are things we know about God. The bible tells us how much God loves us. Through the words of Sacred Scripture God directly speaks to us. Sacred Scripture is not a book of old fables. When I am reading the bible I know God himself is now speaking to me. If the bible says, for example: "You are the light for the world" (Mt:5-14), this also applies to us Christians of today. God believes that we can make the world a bright and beautiful place. Pope Frances says of the bible: "What would happen if we treated the bible like we do our mobile phones? If we went back to retrieve it when we forgot it at home? If we took it out several times a day; if we read God's messages in the bible like we read messages on the mobile phone?"

 Cast all your anxieties on Him, for He cares about you... And after you have suffered a little while, the God of all grace, who has called you to His eternal glory in Christ, will himself restore, establish, and strengthen you (1 Peter 5:7,9-10).
